ORV RESOLUTION

Upon motion made by Gillmore, seconded by Eberhardt,
the following Resolution was made:

"Resolved that the Village of Marion, Michigan, does accept the Osceola County Board of Commissioners guide lines of the ORV Ordinance as follows:

1. To be regulated according to the Michigan Motor Vehicle Code.
2. To comply with but not limited to all basic requirements, (A) a valid drivers license; (B) ORV license sticker; (C) wear an approved crash helmet; (D) operate to the far right of the road wherever possible (E) and if 16 years old or younger have in their possession a valid ORV safety certificate.
3. To be permitted access from Point "A" to Point "B" (example - Home to gas station and the egress to exit the Village by the shortest route possible, or return to Point "A".

This Resolution will be in effect until an ORV Ordinance is adopted by the Village of Marion.
