

VILLAGE OF MARION

ORDINANCE NO. 55- 6-10-91

FORBIDDING ALL CRUSING, CONGREATING, AND TRESPASSING ON ALL VILLAGE PUBLIC PARK LANDS FROM 12:00 A.M. TO 6:00 AM.

The Council of the Village of Marion, Michigan ordains;

It is illegal to trespass, congregate, or cruise on all Village Public land between the hours of 12:00 AM AND 6:00 A. M. This ordinance makes it unlawful for any person to be on park land or have any vehicle upon park lands without a valid purpose during the stated hours.

Valid purposes includes: 1. Duly registered campers at Veterans Memorial Park. 2. Person who have received written permission from the Village Municipal Office to be on the grounds for maintenance or other expressly stated purpose with such authorizations stating the dates of acceptable admittance. Except for these two stated exceptions, all persons are prohibited from entering all Village Parks on foot or by vehicle during the stated hours.

Village Park lands include the Veterans Memorial Park, located off M-66 in the south west corner of Marion and the Mill Pond Pak near Water Street in the Northwest corner of town.

The prohibition shall be posted at the Village Park entrance and shall contain substantially the following language:

NO TRESPASSING, CONGREATING OR CURISING BETWEEN 12:00 am and 6:00 AM. – VIOLATORS WILL BE PROSECUTED.'

This Ordinance shall be enforced by such person or persons as may be designated by the Council of the Village of Marion.

This Ordinance supercedes all other Ordinances inconsistent herewith.

The Ordinance becomes effective thirty (30 days after publication in a newspaper circulating within the Village of Mari
