BILLS: Hopkins moved that the Vendors List dated 5-7-2018 in the amount of \$ 36,850.27 be approved. Seconded by Grundy. Passed.

FINANCIAL REPORT: The Financial Report was reviewed.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Bruce Rendon spoke about running for Senator for the 35<sup>th</sup> District. Donna Geyer and Gail Parkhurst spoke about parking at the Marion Township Hall. When The Old Hotel is torn down they would like to see grass instead of a black top parking lot.

OLD BUSINESS:

Resolution: The Village of Marion resolves that all garbage and refuse containers, except for commercially acceptable dumpsters, shall be placed at the street curbside for pick up. All garbage and/or containers shall be left no sooner than 4:00 p.m. on the day prior to pick up. All containers must be removed from the curbside by 4:00 p.m. the day after pick up.

Motion 1: Pritchard moved, Salisbury seconded, CARRIED, to spend \$4250.00 on the bathroom floors in the Old Bathroom at the park.

Motion 2: Tenney moved, Hopkins seconded, CARRIED, to hire Joe's Tree Service at a cost of \$4000.00 to remove trees at the park.

Motion 3: Salisbury moved, seconded by Pritchard, CARRIED, to spend up to \$10,000.00 on crack seal for Streets.

PART TIME HELP: Put ad in paper for part time summer help for 20 hours a week.

FAIR BOARD CONTRACT: Extend contract for 3 more years.

WAIVER OF FIRST RIGHT OF REFUSAL: The Village of Marion waived the first right of refusal to all parcels that were foreclosed upon in April of 2018.
